Did you know....?

- Global NMI Convention Countdown. Only 10 months until the Global NMI Convention in Indianapolis. Registration takes place Tuesday, June 20; the Convention is from Wednesday morning, June 21, to Friday afternoon, June 23. #NMI2017 #MNI2017.
- NMI Delegates. Please verify with each delegate elected to represent your district at the Global NMI Convention that they will be attending the entire convention. If a delegate prefers to participate in One Heart—Many Hands (OHMH), they will need to allow an alternate to serve. There is still time to make changes; however, those adaptations need to take place soon. Please contact Ana Zoila Diaz Crocker, Regional Coordinator General Assemblies and Conventions, if an alternate will be serving in place of a delegate. - Sending Funds. When sending funds to the United States, please use PO Box 843116, Kansas City, MO 64184, rather than the Prairie Star Parkway address in Lenexa. It is more secure and efficient.
- Missionary Health Care. "It is because of many good people in God's kingdom that our family in our missionary service doesn't have to struggle with medical care and bills. The country where we live has very humid winters, which usually cause breathing problems. We have had to take our two boys, especially our youngest, to the hospital several times. The Missionary Health Care offerings have sustained us in those difficult moments. - Did You Know? Missionary Health Care (MHC)—of which the Memorial Roll and the Distinguished Service Award are a part—provided approximately US \$398,816 in medical assistance for Nazarene missionaries in 2015. The total cost for missionaries' health insurance for the year was US\$1.9 million. World Evangelism Fund (WEF) picks up the balance of the cost. Encouraging participation in MHC allows more WEF money to be used directly for evangelism.
