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
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

Cut the reeds along the solid lines: Beginning with the second reed, fold or cut one reed and not the next so that there is a space between them. Then, fold the sheet along the dotted line. Then, roll each reed with a pencil so that it is somewhat curved and the basket can be seen through the reeds. Read Psalm 121:2. Remember that, although the situation seemed difficult, God had everything under control.




Instructions for assembling phylacteries (I recommend you use adhesive tape instead of glue): (1) Write your name on the lines in the center squares. (2) Cut out the two large squares and the two strips with verses. (3) Fold the squares along the dotted lines. (4) Cut along the black lines in the squares. (5) Glue sections A over sections B to form your phylactery. (6) You will need a long piece of yarn or sturdy string (long enough so you can tie it around your head). Find the center of the yarn. (7) Tape the center of the yarn in the space that says "Glue here" on the bottom of the phylactery. (8) Roll each strip with the Bible verses around a pencil. Place the two verses inside the phylactery. (9) Put the upper box on the lower one. Finally, tie the phylactery to your forehead, as the drawing shows.




