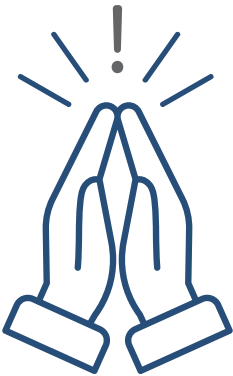
# INTRODUCTION

The World Day of Prayer falls on the first Friday of March every year.

In 1996, Nazarene Missions International joined this movement by observing a week of prayer that incorporates the World Day of Prayer in its schedule. We focus on uniting Nazarenes around the world to pray for the lost, joining God in his mission of grace and love to all.
