INTRODUCTION

What is the Global Week of Prayer?

It is a week when Nazarenes around the world take time each day to talk to God, give thanks, and pray for an area of the world where our church is present and active.

How did it get started?

Prayer is important, and the church around the world understands that we need to pray that God will expand his kingdom with our help. The World Day of Prayer began in 1887 on the first Friday in March. Since then, people around the world have prayed for missions on that day.

When the Church of the Nazarene joined together with other Christians for this purpose, we also saw the need to make this a week-long focus on prayer for missions. We give thanks for all that God has done in and through our church around the world. And we also pray together for our Nazarene Missions family everywhere. You can pray for missions and use this journal throughout the year, but let’s start right now during this special week.

This is your Prayer Journal, so put your name on the front page and get ready for an adventure with God. Pray, write, and draw as you hear about how God is at work through the Church of the Nazarene. Each day, we will pray for one of our six regions around the world. What region are you a part of?

DAY 1—GLOBAL CHURCH

THANK YOU, GOD...

For the pastors, missionaries, leaders, and church members that are sharing your Word around the world. Because of their ministry, our church is growing.



As you color the photo of college-age missionary kids who attended a special gathering called Rendezvous, thank God for this special time of sharing stories, learning, and growing deeper in their relationship with Him.

DEAR JESUS...

Help Nazarenes everywhere, even me, to be more like You when we talk, walk, and do all the things we do each day. Help us to remember that You died on the cross and rose again to save us.

Draw a picture below of you sharing Jesus's love with someone who doesn't know Him.

As you color the world map, think about how big the world is! God loves the people in all of these places because He created them just like He created you.

Pray for all of the missionaries, missionary kids, pastors and pastors' kids who live in different parts of the world. Ask God to keep them safe and to help them share His love with new people each day.

For all of the people in South America that you are calling to go to new places as missionaries. Thank you for those who are planting churches. We ask that more people would be obedient and step out in faith to serve You.

DEAR JESUS...

We pray for South American Nazarenes and for all that you are doing in and through their lives. We pray they will continue to be obedient to your call to serve others. We also pray for the new district in eastern Venezuela, that more people will come to know You through your people there.

Write down or draw three ways you can share Jesus's love with someone in your neighborhood this week.



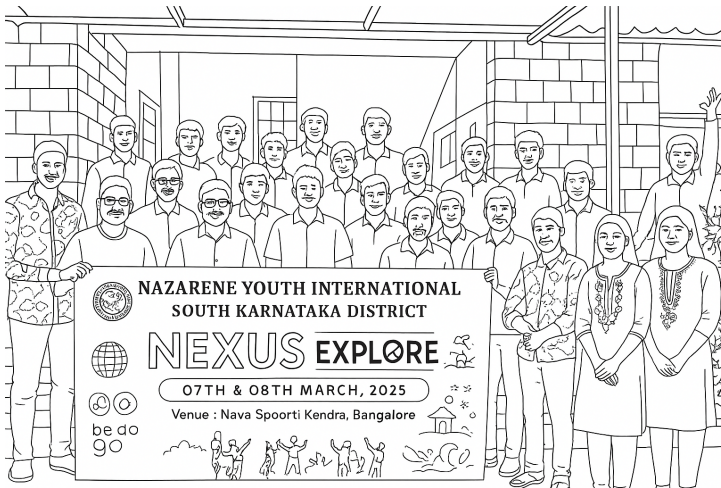

What are some of your gifts? Draw a picture of yourself using your gift to share God's love in a creative way.



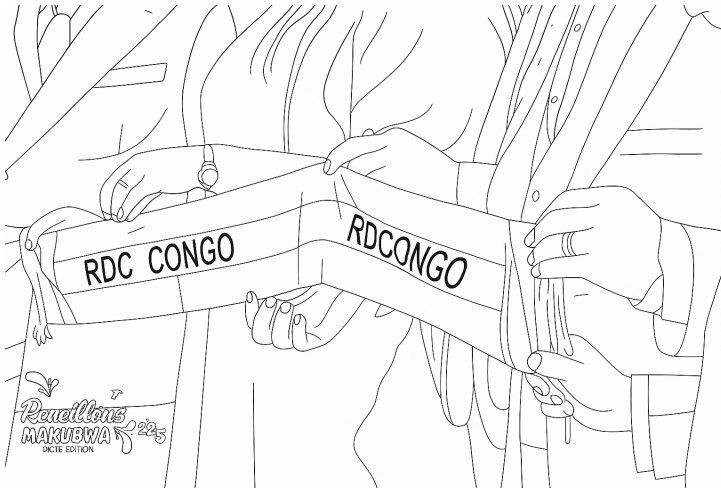

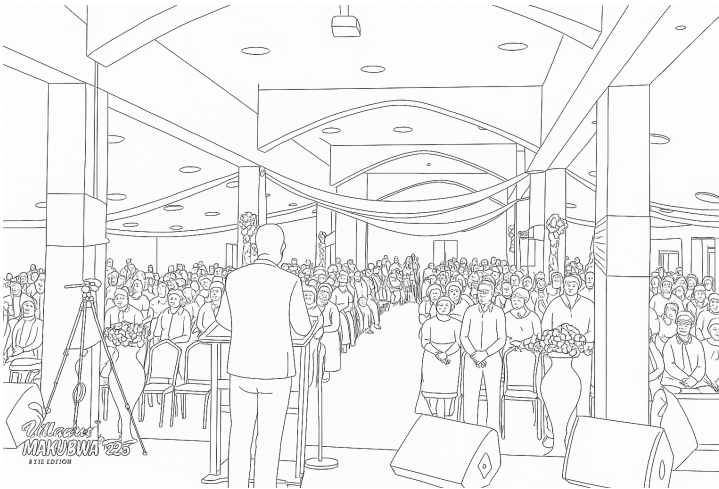

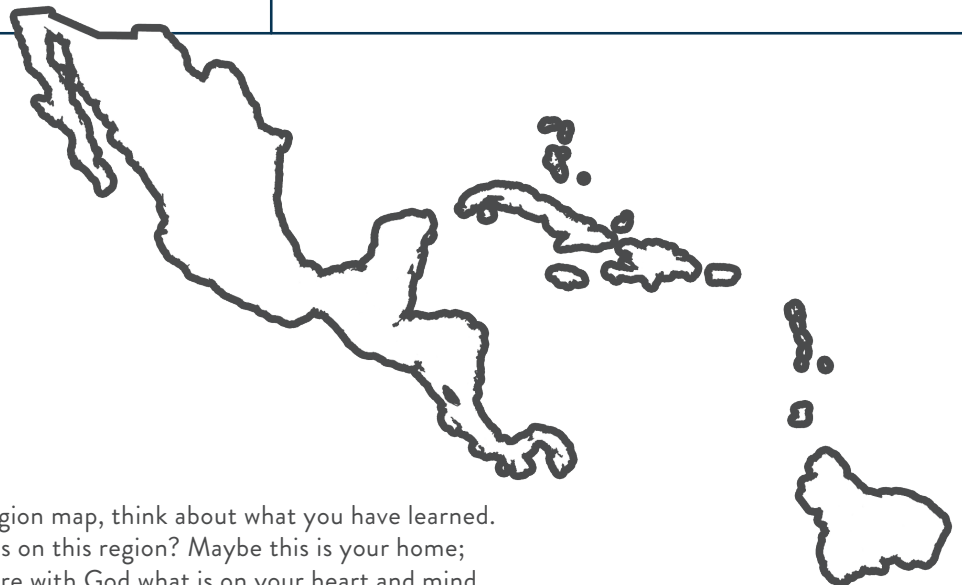

Draw a picture of or list three things you would take with you if you went somewhere new to serve Jesus. Then share with someone you trust why you chose those items.



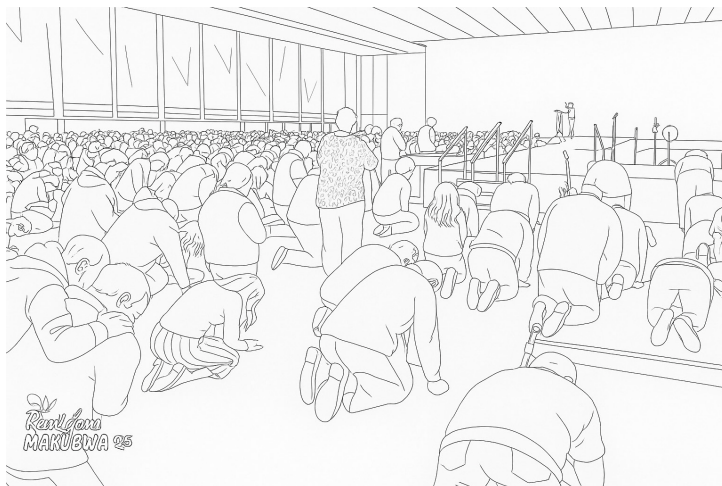
