

PRACTICAL LISTENING INSTRUCTIONS







1. One person in the group will share about a challenge he is facing or a decision he has to make. IT MUST BE REAL, NOT FICTITION.

2. The person will share for three minutes.

3. When you have finished, each of the people who was listening to you, in strict turns, without interrupting, will give you a one-minute summary of what she has understood. THE PERSON SHOULD NOT **INVENT ANYTHING, JUST SUMMARIZE.**

4. The person who shared will check if the summary is correct or not.







PRACTICAL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS







1. On a personal level, each participant writes the answer to these two questions:

a. What was the most important thing that I learned today?

b. What practical step, no matter how small, am I going to take to implement it?

2. Each person will have one minute to share what they have written. The rest listen without comment.
